

Instructions for final paper submission

1. Implement Reviewer's suggestion and remarks in order to obtain final version of the papers.
2. Check out and correct the paper formatting:

The most often met problems with paper formatting:

- 2.1. The problem with formatting often starts when authors do not use temple styles. For each element (e.g. figure caption, formula, table caption) the style is defined. Please use this styles.
- 2.2. Authors affiliations - as written in the temple changing number of authors please: "b) Change number of columns: Select the Columns icon from the MS Word Standard toolbar and then select the correct number of columns from the selection palette."
- 2.3. Please take care about correctness of literature. The examples of correct literature positions:
 - 2.3.1. Article from journal
N. Surname, "Title of article," *Journal name*, vol. 146, pp. 2589–2625, Feb. 2020.
 - 2.3.2. Article from conference
N. Surname1, N. Surname2, and N. Surname2, "Title of article," in *Conference name*, 2016, pp. 1–7
- 2.4. Please use abbreviation during citing the figure in text e.g. "Fig. 1" not "Figure 1" as in a temple. Additionally, figures and tables should be placed at the beginning or end of the column.
- 2.5. Please use correctly dots and commas in numbers and remember about space before units (e.g. 1.45 kV is equal to 1,450 V)

3. Please add in footer the conference number as follow:

- 3.1. For papers in which all authors are employed by the **US government**, the copyright notice is: U.S. Government work not protected by U.S. copyright
- 3.2. For papers in which all authors are employed by a **Crown government** (UK, Canada, and Australia), the copyright notice is: **978-1-7281-7461-7/20/\$31.00 ©2020 Crown**
- 3.3. For papers in which all authors are employed by the **European Union**, the copyright notice is: **978- 1-7281-7461-7/20/\$31.00 ©2020 European Union**
- 3.4. For all other papers the copyright notice is: **978-1-7281-7461-7/20/\$31.00 ©2020 IEEE**

4. Create account on PDF eXpress and convert paper from theirs source application format file to PDF acceptable by IEEE:

- 4.1. A customized PDF eXpress Web page and is available exclusively to conference authors.

- 4.2. First-time users should do the following:
 1. Select the New Users - Click Here link.
 2. Enter the following:
 - **50182X for the Conference ID**
 - your email address
 - a password
- 4.3. Previous users of PDF eXpress need to follow the above steps, but should enter the same password that was used for previous conferences.
- 4.4. Prior to submitting their final papers, authors should visit the conference's PDF eXpress site to either:
 - **check existing PDFs to determine if they are Xplore-compatible (and how to fix the PDFs if they are not).**
 - **convert their papers from their source application formats to Xplore-compatible PDFs.**

5. Submit final version of DOCX and PDF in EasyChair:

- 5.1. The authors who used DOCX as source file format are kindly asked to submit both format files: source DOCX and PDF converted with PDF eXpress.
- 5.2. The authors who used LaTeX to write their paper and uploaded it in PDF format, are kindly asked to submit PDF converted with PDF eXpress.

6. Wait for the assessment of the plagiarism and multiple publication using IEEE CrossCheck Portal:

- 6.1. The CrossCheck Portal is not available for the Authors. It is a tool for the IEEE publication volunteers that in the case of the Conference are the EPQU 2020 Organizers.
- 6.2. The CrossCheck Portal was developed as a centralized place for IEEE publication volunteers to submit manuscripts to CrossCheck in order to check for plagiarism and multiple publication.
- 6.3. The results of the Similarity Reports will be returned to the Authors (if the similarity percentage is under 30%, the results is OK. If not, the review of the paper is necessary).

7. Submit electronic IEEE Copyright Form (IEEE eCF)

- 7.1. Since eCF was incepted in 2004 the printable copies of the IEEE Copyright Form in PDF, HTML, and DOC formats are no longer available. IEEE requires all authors intending to publish in the IEEE Xplore® digital library must provide a transfer of copyright.
- 7.2. The eCF tool can be invoked directly by authors from the access-controlled site. The Authors will be informed about the eCF access-controlled site soon.

8. Information about Non Presented Papers

- 8.1. "IEEE reserves the right to exclude a paper from distribution after the conference, including IEEE Xplore® Digital Library, if the paper is not presented by the author at the conference."
